



Baca Cello Studio – Student Code of Conduct and Tuition Policy

Attendance & Punctuality

Lessons will begin *promptly* at the scheduled time. If you will be late or need to cancel, please call or text your teacher. Tamra will make every effort to reschedule lessons if there has been adequate notice given. No-shows and lessons cancelled without advance notice will be charged at the normal rate and will not be rescheduled.

If Tamra needs to change the lesson time last minute, she will make every attempt to reschedule the lesson. If a reschedule is not reasonably possible, and this cancellation would cause the student to have fewer than 3 lessons for the month, Tamra will calculate the cost of that lesson and count as a credit for next month's lesson tuition.

At the Lesson

Students will arrive ready to learn with their notebook and music. Note taking is an important part of lessons as they serve as a reminder throughout the week on what was discussed during the weekly lesson. Parents of younger children will take notes for their children. Teenage and adult students will either bring a scribe, take notes themselves, or your teacher will take notes for you.

Lesson Materials

Students and parents are responsible for acquiring their own sheet music and music supplies (rosin, strings, etc.). The sheet music used during lessons in this studio will generally be available for purchase from your teacher, thus avoiding an additional trip to the music store. However, if you prefer to purchase your own elsewhere, that is completely acceptable.

Practicing and Listening

Each student will practice a minimum of 5 days each week with a duration no shorter than their lesson time. If you need help organizing your practice time, your teacher is always willing to help.

Listening to the main working pieces is an additional requirement to practicing. Listening helps to internalize the music and make learning, perfecting, and memorizing much easier.

Logistics

Lessons are taught at my home studio in West Jordan. You may park on the street or on the East side of

the driveway. If you have younger children in attendance at another child's lesson, there is a park around the corner where they may play and run around if needed.

Tuition and Fees

Please have your tuition check delivered in person at the lesson or have the check in the mail by the 7th of each month. If tuition is paid/mailed after the 7th, please plan to include a required \$10 late fee with the tuition payment. You may pay your tuition via PayPal, check, or cash. Many students choose to send their tuition via their bank's automatic bill payment. If you choose to pay in this manner, please send your payment to:
